



University of Akron, Lorain County Community College open Brunswick site

The University of Akron and Lorain County Community College are partnering to open a higher education location in Brunswick.

The Midpoint Campus Center will open in January on the third floor of the Highland Square building at 50 Pearl Road. A temporary suite on the first floor of the building is now open for prospective students to meet with advisors and begin planning their course schedules.

Midpoint is opening in response to Gov. Ted Strickland's call to have a college education available to all Ohioans within 30 miles of their home. It will be located at the intersection of southern Lorain County, Brunswick and Strongsville, which is a geographic area underserved by higher education, the two schools said.
