

## Allegro Realty Advisors holds grand opening celebration for new Cleveland headquarters

CLEVELAND - Allegro Realty Advisors officially opened its new headquarters on Wednesday in Cleveland. Mayor Frank Jackson and Council Members Joseph Cimperman and Phyllis Cleveland attended the grand opening celebration.

The Allegro offices, previously located in Valley View, have moved to the second floor of 1938 Euclid Avenue, east of Playhouse Square. Cleveland's Vacant Property Initiative provided a \$500,000 loan, with \$175,000 being forgiven, to assist with renovations to the property.

The 15,000 square foot building was originally built in the early 1900s and had been vacant for several years. The first floor has been leased to Jimmy John's Gourmet Sandwiches and Moe's Southwest Grill.

So far, new tenants in the building have brought 28 new employees and a payroll of over \$1.2 million to Cleveland.
